							STAR and Physical Fitness Test: Overall test window is Mar. 23 - April 28 . Specific test dates and location will be mailed to students in January. STAR Writing test is for 4th and 7th grade only: March 1st or (2nd for makeups)		

CELDT: Initial (within 30 days of enrollment) or Annual (by 10/31/10) as scheduled

WRAT: pre-test and post-test for K-3 as scheduled

SCANTRON: pre-test and post-test for Grades 4-11 (and some 12th graders) as scheduled

CAHSEE(California High School Exit Exam): Grades 10, 11, 12 participate. Beginning with the Class of 2006, all public school students will be required to pass the CAHSEE to earn a high school diploma. 10th graders can only attempt one time per year and it must be in the Spring. 11th graders can only attempt two times per year. 12th graders can attempt three times per year. There are two parts to the exam; ELA(English Language Arts) is administered one day, and Math is administered the next day.

CELDT(California English Language Development Test) : This is a State-required test for English language proficiency that must be given to students in grades K-12 whose primary language is other than English. If the language questions on the CWCS application are answered with any other language than English, those students must be tested within 30 days of enrollment for Initial testing. Annual testing is administered once a year, by October 31st to students who tested the previous year and were placed as an English Learner.

PFT(Physical Fitness Test): Only grades 5, 7, 9 participate. The test window runs from Feb-May. We do the bulk of our testing during the STAR test window for logistical reasons.

Scantron (Online School Pre-Test and Post-Test): Scantron is administered in fall and early spring. This test is used as both a diagnostic tool and as a performance indicator on an individual student basis. Scantron is for students in grades 4-11 and only those 12th graders in CAHSEE intensive. If your 12th grader has passed both sections of the CAHSEE, no pre/post tests are required.

STAR(Standardized Testing and Reporting): Grades 2-11 participate.

WRAT(Wide Range Achievement Test): ESs are required to administer the WRAT to students in grades K-3 within 30 days of initial enrollment in CWCS.
