**A. To qualify for CSF membership this semester, follow these guidelines:**

- a. You must earn a *minimum of 10 points* from last semester’s grades.
  - i. The first 4 points must be from LIST I (unless you are a senior applying in the spring semester or at graduation).
  - ii. The first 7 points must be (including 4 points from LIST I) must be from both LIST I and LIST II.
  - iii. The remaining points may come from any LIST (I, II, or III).
- b. You must use *no more than 5 courses* to qualify.
- c. *No* CSF points are given for PE or courses taken in lieu of PE, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving clerking and office/teaching assistant, and courses taken on a pass/fail basis.
- d. CSF points are granted as follows:
  - A = 3 CSF points
  - B = 1 CSF point
  - C = 0 CSF point
  - D or F in any course, even in one you cannot use to qualify, disqualifies you from membership.

\*\*One additional point shall be granted for a grade of A or B in an AP, IB or Honors course up to a maximum of 2 such points for a semester.

**B. Also remember:**

- a. Semester membership is based on work done in the *previous* semester.
- b. You must ***reapply each semester.***
- c. The courses you may use for LIST I, II, III are attached to this application.
